INTRO: BAKER RIVER RACING'S HISTORY TRACES BACK TO THE EARLY 2000S, BEGINNING WITH 500CC WINGLESS MINI SPRINTS AT WINCHESTER SPEEDPARK IN NEW HAMPSHIRE. AS THE TEAM EVOLVED, THEY TRANSITIONED THROUGH VARIOUS RACING DISCIPLINES, INCLUDING 270 MICROS AND MINI STOCKS, BEFORE FOCUSING ON ASPHALT RACING AT VENUES LIKE WATERFORD SPEEDBOWL IN CONNECTICUT. AFTER A BRIEF HIATUS FROM ACTIVE RACING, ADRIAN REIGNITED HIS PASSION AND THE TEAM PURCHASED A D2 MIDGET, EARNING ACCOLADES SUCH AS ROOKIE OF THE YEAR WITH THE USAC DMA CLUB. FOLLOWING A MOVE TO TO MISSISSIPPI TWO YEARS AGO, ADRIAN MADE THE SWITCH TO AN OPEN 305 SPRINT CAR AND COMPETES PRIMARILY WITH THE POWRI SOUTHERN SPRINT CAR ASSOCIATION (SCCA) RENEGADE SPRINTS AT TRACKS ACROSS THE MIDWEST AND SOUTH.
